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## Curriculum Newsletter – Term 5 – Cherry Class

### English

We will be using the Power of Reading Take 5 series for some of our English work. Additional work will be set using either BBC Bitesize or the Oak National Academy. Please ensure you check Seesaw or the school website to see which specific elements are relevant to your child.

### Maths

We are continuing to use the White Rose scheme and the BBC Bitesize programme complements this. We will direct you to the relevant areas via Seesaw and the school website. This term we will re-visit areas of previous learning such as fractions and begin to look at measurement of length in cm and m.

Remember to practise your times tables using TT Rockstars.

### Wider Curriculum

We will be learning about The Normans and the Battle of Hastings in History and examining art relating to this period including the Bayeux Tapestry. In Science we will look at the growth and needs of animals including humans. In RE we will begin to look at the religion of Islam and what Muslims believe.

### Everything Else

Remember to look after each other – it is a very unusual time for all of us and we look forward to the time when we can all be back together at school.

In the meantime, ensure you get enough exercise – play in your gardens or go for a walk or cycle with your family. Use this time to try out new activities – such as baking (a great way to use maths and science practically and hopefully something tasty at the end!), play some board or card games.
