Joint Local Governing Body Structure

The make-up of the Brenzett & Kingsnorth Joint Governing Body (JLGB) is set down as follows:

A maximum total membership of 18 governors is allowed, to include:

9 x Director - Appointed Governors by the Diocese of Canterbury:

The above members include representatives from the local authority, Diocese, PCC, both Incumbents (who are ex-officio) and from local and business communities

2 x Co-opted Governors:

This category of governor are co-opted for their particular expertise, or for specific projects etc.

FULL LOCAL GOVERNING BODY

All members of the Joint LGB attend full Local Governing Body meetings, and have EQUAL voting rights.

The Joint Governing Body has TWO working groups, who meet separately:

The Joint Resources Group

Having responsibilities for: Budget, personnel, premises, grounds & insurance, health & safety, risk management, safeguarding and safe recruitment.

Current members represent both schools and include the Exec Headteacher, Chair of Governors, a Kingsnorth parent governor, a staff governor, two Director Appointed governors, and the Kingsnorth incumbent. The Finance Officer can also attend this committee when her input and expertise is required.

The Joint Learning & Development Group

With responsibilities for: Curriculum, child protection/safeguarding, performance data, monitoring and target setting, admissions, out of school trips, extended services (e.g. lettings, breakfast club, community links), SEND and pupil premium

Membership represents both schools and includes the Brenzett incumbent, a parent governor, a staff governor, a co-opted governor who is the Assistant HT and four director appointed governors.

The two Heads of School are able to attend BOTH meetings for their expertise. They are NOT governors and not entitled to vote.

The Executive Headteacher may sit in on any of the Groups, as appropriate to the business of their meetings.

The Chair of the Joint LGB may also attend any of the Group meetings as appropriate to the business of their meetings
