## It's a good to be Green day

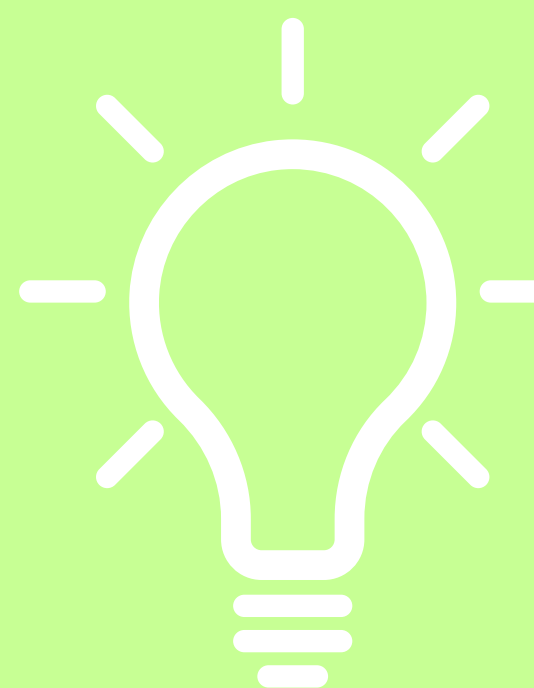

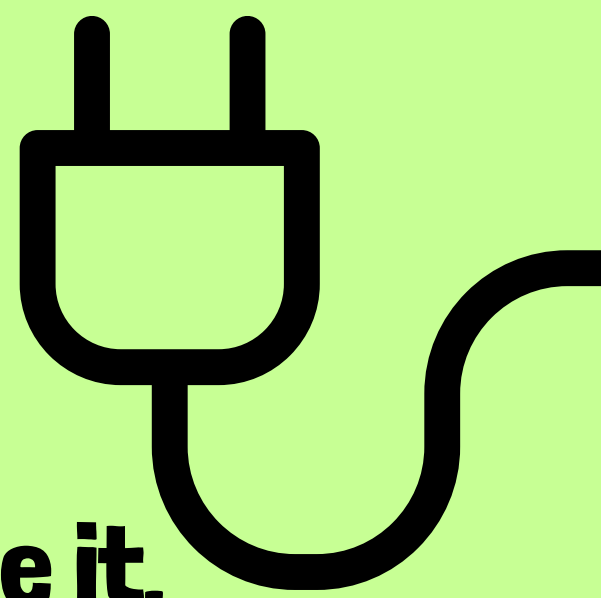
# How can we help?

**Recycle and reuse when you can.**

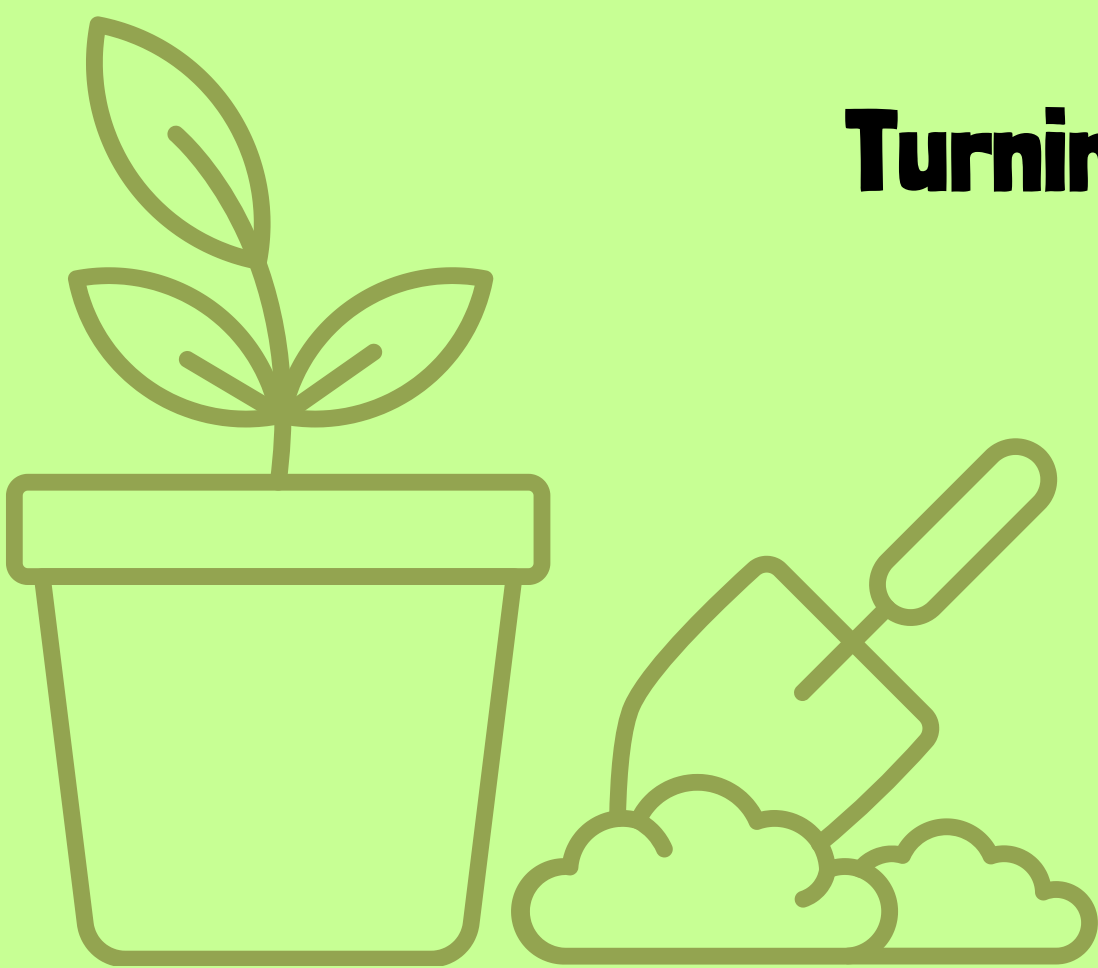


**Picking up litter and put it in the bin or recycle it.**
