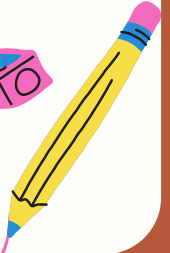
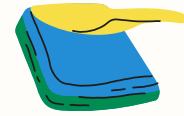


Acorn Class Term 6 Newsletter



What's happening this term:

Phonics - Phonics is where we learn our pure sounds. We will be recapping our set 1 initial sounds and within our set groups be learning set 1 digraphs, set 2 digraphs and trigraphs and set 3 digraphs, trigraphs and split-digraphs

Literacy - In literacy we will be reading a book a week based around our topic 'What a wonderful world' We will be exploring the wider world and its amazing animals and creatures that live in a variety of habitats. We will be reading the books; Rumble in the Jungle, How the camel got its hump, The very hungry caterpillar & The bad tempered lady bird, The very greedy bee, Somebody swallowed Stanley, Brave little penguin, and The snail and the whale.

Maths - In maths we will be learning a variety of mathematical processes that will help to deepen our knowledge of number. We are focussing sharing and grouping, patterns, time to o'clock, creating maps and positional language.

RE - The continuing theme for RE this term is Salvation and our big question is 'Which stories are special and why?' focusing on a variety of different religions; Judaism, Hinduism, Sikhism, and Muslim.

ART - Sculpture and 3D- Modelling using a variety of materials beginning with playdough, and creating sketches for our final piece as we create an animal sculpture using modelling clay.

PSHE - Managing myself - We are exploring how to keep ourselves fit and healthy whilst discussing the next exciting adventure into Year 1.

Music - We will be exploring instruments and what makes a band/orchestra whilst creating our own instruments.

PE - PE this term will be children working on their athletic skills in preparation for sports day this term

Understanding the world - This term we will be discovering different animals and their habitats, looking at devastating elements across the world such as deforestation, littering, decline of animal populations and what we can do to save the animals from distinction.
